If your VIN starts with "4UZ," you are a valued member of the FCOC family, whether your coach is built on an S2RV or XC chassis. While there are some differences in the chassis layouts, we all share the same core components—engines, transmissions, tires, generators, and more. We're all united in our passion for RVing, adventure, and the community that comes with it.

It seems there's been some confusion stemming from an external group that serves Super C owners across different RV manufacturers. Although I made several attempts to connect with this group and extend an invitation to join our community, I was unfortunately not able to engage in a meaningful way. This may have contributed to the perception that the FCOC isn't open or welcoming to all Super C owners, which is simply not the case.





TRAVELING IN STYLE: BOB AND KELLY CEFELI'S JOURNEY WITH THEIR TIFFIN PHAETON RV

Bob and Kelly Cefeli's journey is one of transformation, resilience, and the power of embracing freedom. After purchasing a 2025 Tiffin Phaeton 37BH motorhome, the couple turned their dream of traveling across the country into a reality—one that started unexpectedly during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Before their RV adventure, Bob and Kelly led the demanding life of running a busy retail store, working 14 to 16 hours a day. "The work-life balance was all over the place," says Bob. As an escape from their hectic routine, the couple bought a small travel trailer and camped just a mile from their store. "It became our little retreat," Kelly recalls. "Even though it was tight, it offered those moments of peace, away from the grind."

A LIFE-ALTERING DIAGNOSIS AND A NEW CHAPTER

When Bob was diagnosed with Parkinson's disease, it forced the couple to confront the reality that their future trips could be impacted. The possibility that Bob might not be able to drive long distances led them to reconsider their travel setup. A motorhome would provide mobility and the ability to travel comfortably, without the need for a truck and trailer combination Kelly couldn't drive.

"We'd never been in anything larger than a 22-foot trailer," Bob admits. But the allure of Class A motorhomes, especially the Tiffin Phaeton, began to take shape. "We had no idea what 40 feet would feel like," Kelly says.

After thorough research and exploring their options, they attended an RV show in Hershey, Pennsylvania. There, they met Joe Snyder, a Freightliner engineer, who walked them through the motorhome's engineering details. Bob, an engineer by trade, was immediately captivated by the meticulous design, from the air suspension to the chassis features that ensured safety on the road. "It was the details that made it clear this was the right decision," says Bob.

STEPPING INTO THE DRIVER'S SEAT

Soon after their purchase, the couple found themselves in unfamiliar territory. "We had never driven anything this big," Bob laughs. But with the support of the Colton RV staff, Kelly learned the ropes of driving the motorhome. "I never thought I could do it, but now I love it," she says with a smile. As they hit the road, the Cefelis discovered a new sense of freedom. "There's something so freeing about leaving everything behind when we drive off, no obligations, no responsibilities just us, together, rediscovering the joy of life on the open road."



ROADSIDE RECEPES



SWEETHEART STRAWBERRY CHEESECAKE CUPS

These adorable, no-bake cheesecake cups are a perfect Valentine's Day treat. With a creamy cheesecake layer, luscious strawberry topping, and a graham cracker crust, they're easy to make and full of love! (Serves 6.)

CRUST:

- 1 cup graham cracker crumbs
- 2 tbsp granulated sugar
- 4 tbsp melted butter

CHEESECAKE LAYER:

- 8 oz cream cheese, softened
- 1/3 cup powdered sugar
- 1 tsp vanilla extract
- 1 cup whipped topping (like Cool Whip)

STRAWBERRY TOPPING

- 1 cup fresh strawberries, diced
- 1/4 cup granulated sugar
- 1 tsp lemon juice
- 1 tbsp cornstarch
- 2 tbsp water

GARNISH:

- Fresh strawberries (halved or heart-shaped, optional)
- Pink or red sprinkles
- Whipped cream

DIRECTIONS:

1. Make the Crust:

In a bowl, mix graham cracker crumbs, sugar, and melted butter until combined. Divide evenly among 6 small cups or jars, pressing down to form a firm crust layer. Chill in the refrigerator while preparing the other layers.

2. Prepare the Cheesecake Layer:

LUCKY LEPRECHAUN MINT CHOCOLATE PARFAITS

This easy-to-make St. Patrick's Day dessert combines layers of minty goodness with chocolatey delight. Perfect for parties, kids, or anyone feeling the Irish spirit! (Serves 6.)

MINT LAYER:

- 1 package (3.4 oz) instant vanilla pudding mix
- 2 cups cold milk
- 1 tsp peppermint extract
- Green food coloring (5-6 drops or as desired)
- 1 cup whipped topping (like Cool Whip)

CHOCOLATE LAYER:

- 1 package (3.4 oz) instant chocolate pudding mix

- 2 cups cold milk

CRUMB LAYER:

- 1 cup chocolate sandwich cookies (like Oreos, crushed

TOPPING:

- Whipped cream
- Green sprinkles
- Mini chocolate chips or chocolate shavings
- Optional: Gold candy coins or shamrock-shaped candies

DIRECTIONS:

1. Prepare the Mint Pudding Layer::

In a medium bowl, whisk together the vanilla pudding mix and 2 cups of cold milk until it thickens (about 2 minutes). Stir in peppermint extract and green food coloring until you get a vibrant green shade. Fold in 1 cup of whipped topping to create a creamy texture. Chill in the fridge for 10 minutes.


